



Welcoming Visitors back to Tandridge GC

Covid-19 Code of Conduct

For those visitors wishing to play at Tandridge Golf Club, the Operations team has assembled a plan as set out below, which identifies the measures to be adopted in recognition of concerns around Covid-19. These measures are compliant with government guidelines and have been informed by guidance published by the R&A, England Golf and others.

The course set up will be very similar to that which was in place immediately before lockdown. Benches, bins, bunker rakes and ball-washers will be removed or taken out of use and hole cups will have an insert such that the ball falls only partially in to the hole.

All players must pre-book a tee time by contacting the Professional Shop. Without a pre-booked tee time, you will not be allowed access to the course or practice facilities.

When playing a round of golf, players are asked to observe the following Covid-19 Code of Conduct:

- On arrival, park leaving a clear space between cars if possible.
- Come to the Club dressed for golf. The Clubhouse remains closed, please change your shoes in the car park.
- Please arrive only 10-20 minutes before your tee time. If you need to warm up with a few shots or practice putts, this will be possible but please observe the limitations below.
- Before making use of the practice facilities or accessing the course, please register with the Professional Shop. You will also be reminded of the social-distancing protocols and any Local Rules.
- Access to the course from the car park will be via the path at the top of the car park adjacent to the disabled parking signs, leading down to the 1st tee.
- The Clubhouse remains closed but there are two washrooms on the course; leading to the 6th tee and 14th tee.
- Keep your distance from the 1st tee, do not progress further than the practice nets until the group ahead of you has teed off.

- On the course, only touch your own ball. Do not pick up stray golf balls.
- Do not touch the flagsticks.
- Do your best to smooth bunkers without using a rake.
- Look after your own litter and take it home with you.
- On completion of the round, exit the course by the designated route, following the pathway from the back of the 18th green leading to the car park. Please do not wait around in the car park or on the terrace area - leave the premises as soon as possible and stay safe.

Practice Facilities - if using the practice hole, chipping green (maximum of four players at any one time) and or putting green (maximum of four players), please use your own equipment. Players using the practice range may purchase a bucket of range balls from the Professional Shop. Appropriate social-distancing has been observed and enforced on the range – please follow the directional signage on leaving the area.

The practice nets, towards the 1st tee, are available. Again, please use your own equipment.

The Professional's Shop will be open, whilst social-distancing restrictions are in place; please follow the clear signage.

The Clubhouse remains closed, there is no access to the changing rooms or toilets.

The Club recognises that we are currently unable to provide the full hospitality experience you would otherwise enjoy; our focus at this time is to ensure that we can provide a golfing experience that is safe for you, our Members and our staff. The Club believes that by following the above guidelines, players will have the best opportunity to safely enjoy their golf.

The Club will continue to review these practices and reserves the right to change and amend without prior notice.

Please enjoy your game, remembering to Play safe, Stay safe.
