

# Dress Code



Tandridge Golf Club wants everyone to feel welcome, part of the club and therefore requires all to be appropriately dressed on the Golf Course, Practice areas, Driving Range and in the Clubhouse. On the Golf Course, our guideline is any recognised golfing apparel available in our Pro Shop.

You will be politely asked to change or leave if you are unable to comply with our dress code.

Headwear	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Peaked headwear must be worn facing forward</li><li>• All headwear should be removed indoors</li></ul>
Shirts/Tops	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• All shirts/tops must have a collar, including standup collar styles</li><li>• Collarless base layers may be worn as an undergarment only</li><li>• T-shirts, rugby and football tops are not allowed</li><li>• Mens' shirts must always be tucked in. Women's tops should be tucked in unless the style is clearly designed to be worn outside trousers, shorts, skort or skirt</li></ul>
Shorts Skorts Skirts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• All trousers, shorts, skorts and skirts must be tailored</li><li>• Track suits, gym leggings, dirty or ripped jeans, and cargo-style clothing is not allowed anywhere</li></ul>
Socks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Short socks must be visible above the shoe line. No invisible socks</li><li>• Men should wear short white socks but may also wear black or navy socks if these match their shoes</li><li>• Women should wear short white socks, or socks matching their outfit</li><li>• Knee length socks may be any colour</li></ul>
Footwear	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Please do not change your shoes in the car park</li><li>• Golf shoes with spikes, soft spikes or moulded soles must be worn.</li><li>• Trainers or other casual shoes are strictly prohibited on the golf course, practice area and driving range. Flip flops/sliders cannot be worn anywhere</li><li>• Clean, dry, non-spike golf shoes may be worn in the lounge and bars of the club house on carpeted areas but are not allowed in the dining room</li></ul>
Dining Room	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Attire must be appropriate for the event and as instructed by the event organiser who works closely with the General Manager and his team</li></ul>
