

# Dress Code



Tandridge Golf Club requires everyone to be appropriately dressed when at the Golf Club.

The Club reserves the right to assess this on a case-by-case basis.

The Club also has the authority to deny anyone access to our facilities if these rules are infringed.

## **WE EXPECT ALL MEMBERS AND VISITORS TO WEAR:**

- A respectable standard of dress at all times.
- Smart casual attire in the dining room.
- Recognised golf clothing on the course.
- Appropriate footwear both on and off the golf course.

## **WE REQUIRE THAT:**

- Mobile phone calls are only to be made and received in the car park.
- Men's shirts are tucked in.
- Short socks, when worn with shorts or skirts, must be predominately white or the same colour as the bulk of the shoe.
- Shorts must be tailored.
- Caps and hats are not to be worn in the clubhouse. If caps are worn outside, they must have their peaks at the front.

## **NOT PERMITTED:**

- ✗ Tracksuits, t-shirts, cargo or combat trousers, rugby and football shirts.
- ✗ Wet/muddy clothing or shoes in the clubhouse area.
- ✗ Shorts, jeans and golfing attire in the dining room.
